DISTRIBUTION OF THE GRADES

Final Examination	50%
Home work	30%
Compulsory reading (Books, notes, etc)	20%

COMPULSORY READING:

All students taking the course for credits must have at least 500 pages of reading. The student will fill out a form listing the books and the total number of pages read, attesting that the required reading has been done. It is the professor who chooses the reading he desires to give for his course.

HOME WORK:

All students taking the course for credits must have homework based on the books and studies given. The student will have 30 days to send his work to the professor, who will correct and mark the work done. An extension is possible (at the professors discretion) but only for a maximum of another 30 days. If the homework has not been received within the required time, the student will automatically lose the percentage given for that section of marks.

FINAL EXAM:

All students taking the course for credits must take a final exam. The student will take the exam at home and fill out the form attesting that he will use only the tools stipulated by the professor. It is the professor, who will grade the final exam. Once all the three sections have been graded the professor will send the exam, homework, and attestation of reading back to *CORPUS* Bible Institute for their files. The professor must give a final grade for each student who is taking the course for credits..
